SCHEDULE "B"

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA

"STREET COLLECTIONS BYLAW 1977"

Permission is hereby granted to the volunteers from:

SCOUTS CANADA, GREATER VICTORIA AREA

to exercise the privilege of soliciting aid in the streets and highways of the City of Victoria, with the exception of City Parks, the Inner Harbour area, and the sidewalks and areas surrounding Beacon Hill Park.

The Scouts Apple Day fund-raising campaign in the City of Victoria will be held on Saturday, October 1, 2011, 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., subject to the provisions of the "*Street Collections Bylaw, 1977*" and subject to the following conditions:

- Canvasser to wear a prominently displayed tag bearing the name of the above noted organization;
- Canvasser to produce identification including name and address and Schedule "B" if requested by a bylaw enforcement officer;
- No chattels on City Streets and sidewalks (e.g. tables, chairs, etc.);
- No distribution of products or merchandise on City property (e.g. brochures, T-shirts, etc.);
- Canvassers not to canvass in the same location on 2 consecutive days, and also not more than twice during the course of one week;
- No more than two canvassers from any organization are to occupy any one of the four corners of an intersection;
- Canvassers not to canvass within in front of or within 5 meters of residential entrances, business entrances and business show windows.
